

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the consolidated chapelry or benefice of All Saints, Croxley Green, in the county of Hertford, and in the diocese of Rochester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same consolidated chapelry or benefice, all those annual tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us; to have and to hold the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same consolidated chapelry or benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the eighteenth day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
