

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the rectory of Edmondbyers, in the county of Durham, and in the diocese of Durham, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same rectory, all those pieces or parcels of land and hereditaments, situate within the parish of Edmondbyers aforesaid, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and now vested in us: To have and to hold the said pieces or parcels of land and hereditaments, with their appurtenances, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction, consisting of eleven acres three roods and twenty-nine perches of land, with the house and other buildings thereon, which has been permanently secured to the vicarage of Saint John, Withyham, in the county of Sussex, and in the diocese of Chichester, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Saint John, Withyham, and to his successors, to meet such benefaction, one yearly sum or stipend of thirty-six pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the day of the publication of these presents in the London

Gazette, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient, in our opinion, to produce the said yearly sum or stipend, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said vicarage, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.
