Revolving Light at Parahiba.

THE Harbour Master at Parahiba, Brazil, has given notice, that a light is now exhibited from a lighthouse recently erected at the entrance of Parahiba River.

The light is a *revolving* white light, *eclipsed* at intervals of *one minute*, elevated 52 feet above high water, and in clear weather should be seen from a distance of 12 miles.

The lighthouse is situated on Pedra Secra Rocks, at the Cabedello Bar, and half a mile
