

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Saint John, Blackford, in the county of Cumberland, and in the diocese of Carlisle, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all those annual tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges hereby expressed to be granted and conveyed, shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in substitution for a portion, amounting to thirty-six pounds of the annual sum or stipend of one hundred and fifty pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage, under the authority of an Instrument sealed by us on the twenty-seventh-day of April, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, and published in the London Gazette of the fifth day of the month of May following: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
