Venice, Decemb. 3. The Princes of *Brunswick, Wirtemberg, Hesse-Darmstadt, and Turenne*, with several other Persons of Quality, are arrived here from *Negrepoint*, who give an account, That the *Venetians* having, on the 12th of *October*, stormed the place, and being repulsed after a bloody and obstinate Fight, the *Doge*, not to ruine his Army, which was very much weakened by their former Losses, had raised the Siege, the Troops embarking, with all the Artillery, Provisions, &c. without the least Disturbance from the Enemy, who, fearing the *Venetians* only feigned a Retreat to draw them out of the place, durst not make any Sallies upon them. The *Doge* was himself returned to *Napoli di Romania*, having settled the Winter-quarters for the Troops, and ordered 24 Men of War to continue at Sea to cruise in the *Archipelago*.

Vienna, Decemb. 5. The 3d instant arrived here a Courier from *Italy*, with Advice, that the Republick of *Venice* is willing to make an Honorable Peace with the Ottoman Port, in case their Allies are enclined thereunto; And that they had resolved, for that purpose, to send a full Power to their Ambassador here to enter upon a Treaty jointly with the Imperial Ministers, and such as should be appointed on the part of the Crown of *Poland*, with the Turkish Ambassadors; Who, it's believed, will now in few days be admitted to an Audience of his Imperial Majesty. The Imperial Regiments commanded towards the *Rhine* have Orders to hasten their march, and to raise Recruits in the Countries through which they pass. The Baron *Zieroeski* is on his departure for *Poland*, to be present at the Meeting of the General Diet of the Kingdom. Count *Caraffa*, Commissary-General of that Army
