THE Board of Trade have received through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a Despatch from Her Majesty's Minister at Buenos Ayres, upon the subject of the Harbour of Eusenada, in the River Plate, which has lately been constituted a port of entry:

A translation of a Decree in the matter made by the National Government is subjoined:—

*Buenos Aires, May 20, 1874.*

THE Port of Eusenada being hereby constituted for the purposes of home and of foreign trade, and a comptroller's department having been provided for in the estimates, with a view to avoid the inconvenience to which commerce might be subjected owing to its vicinity to the port of Buenos Aires which involves the necessity of the presentation of documents in duplicate:

The President of the Republic determines and decrees—

ART. 1. The Comptroller's Department at Eusenada will commence its operations on and from the 1st June next.

ART. 2. The duties of the Comptroller's Department are restricted as regards such vessels as may carry on operations in the port of Buenos Aires and in that of Eusenada simultaneously, to mere prevention duties dependent on the custom-house of Buenos Aires.

ART. 3. Let this be promulgated, &c.
