CEREMONIAL observed at the BAPTISM of HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE ALFRED ALEXANDER WILLIAM ERNEST ALBERT, Grandson of HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN, and of HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE PRINCE CONSORT, Son of HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH, and of HER ROYAL AND IMPERIAL HIGHNESS THE DUCHESS OF EDINBURGH (GRAND DUCHESS OF RUSSIA), at Buckingham Palace, on Monday, the 23rd of November, 1874, at One o'clock.

THE Ceremony took place in the Lower Bow Room.

The Royal Family assembled in the Carnarvon Room.

The Household in attendance and the Company invited to be present assembled in the Green Drawing Room, and from thence were shown to the seats provided for them in the Lower Bow Room.

The Archbishop of Canterbury, the Honourable and Very Reverend the Dean of Windsor (Resident Chaplain to Her Majesty), the Dean of Westminster (Deputy Clerk of the Closet and Honorary Chaplain to Her Majesty), and the Rev. W. L. Onslow, M.A. (Chaplain to His Royal Highness the Prince of Wales), took their places near the Font.
