THE Board of Trade have received from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a copy of a Decree of the Greek Government, dated 2 October last, changing the Tariff Classification of certain articles and abolishing the import duties on iron anchors, chains, ships' pumps, sheathing plates of yellow metal and zinc, and nails of similar materials for fixing such plates.
