

NAVAL PRIZE MONEY.

NOTICE is hereby given to all persons interested therein, that preparations are now being made for the intended distribution of the tonnage bounty awarded for a slave dhow the "Bora Salaam," captured on the 20th June, 1873, by Her Majesty's ship "Briton."

Agents or other persons having any just and legal demand, unliquidated, against the said award, are required to transmit the particulars of any such demand to the Registrar of the High Court of Admiralty, in order that the same may be examined, taxed, and allowed by that Officer, and paid under the sanction of the Judge of the said Court.

Due notice will be given, by future advertisement in the London Gazette, of the date proposed for the commencement of distribution; and, at the same time, the amount of an individual's share in the respective classes will be announced.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction, consisting of a clear annual rent-charge of eighteen pounds, which has been permanently secured to

the vicarage of the Holy Trinity, Whitehaven, in the county of Cumberland, and in the diocese of Carlisle, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, grant to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of the Holy Trinity Whitehaven, and to his successors, to meet such benefaction, one yearly sum or stipend of fifty-five pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the twentieth day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-five, and to be receivable in equal half-yearly portions, on the first day of May and on the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that if at any time lands, tithes, or other hereditaments sufficient, in our opinion, to produce the said yearly sum or stipend of fifty-five pounds, or any part thereof, shall be annexed by us to the said rectory, in substitution for such yearly sum or stipend, or for such part thereof, our liability for the payment of such yearly sum or stipend, or of such part thereof, as the case may be, shall thereupon and thereafter cease and determine.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of the Holy Trinity, Northwood, in the counties of Middlesex and Hertford, and in the diocese of London, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular those annual tithe commutation rent-charges, which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us; To have and to hold the said annual tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said tithe commutation rent-charges, for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-first day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-three, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
