Hereas upon Our Galling together the Erces, We have appointed Juch Officers to Command claim, in whom We may Repose entire Trust and Considence, as well for their Readincs and Inclination for Our Service, as for their Gare and Disipence in keeping the Jaid Ferces in good Order and Discipline: And having out of the tender Regard and favourable Consideration which We shall always express for the good Service and dutiful Behaviour of the Forces, taken Care for their Maintenance and Encouragement, and given Orders for the fatasting and making good to every Officer and Soldier their full Pay and Arrears due to them until the First day of this Instant January, and for the making constant and punctual Payment of the Subssistance-Money, and Clearings of the Army in the usual Method wishout any the least diminution of the former Pay; We have thought fit hereby to declare the same, that no Officer or Soldier may be missed, or diverted from Our Service by any groundless Reports, or malicious Instinuations, strictly Charging and Requiring all Officers to repair forthwith to their respective Commands, and all Soldiers to their respective Commands, and all Soldiers to their default as the Nature of their Offences shall descrive. And if it shall so happen, that notwithstanding these Our Gracious Intentions and Offer of Pardon for their pass Apprehending of all Soldiers that leave described and Apprehending of all Soldiers that leave described, or shall describe service, in order to the bringing them so Condayn Punishment, to be institled upon them with the utmost Severity.
