

Provided that the Guardians may accept as a security the guarantee of any Company or Association which shall undertake to guarantee the good conduct of such officers, and shall give such guarantee in a security, the form whereof shall have been approved by the Poor Law Board or the Local Government Board under their Seal.

ARTICLE VI.—The Auditor of the district comprising the said Wandsworth and Clapham Union shall, in the statement relating to the securities of the officers of the Union, which, under the Orders in that behalf, he is required to transmit to the Local Government Board, include the name of the Vestry Clerk for the said parish of Clapham for the time being appointed under the authority aforesaid, together with the particulars required in the said Orders, and shall report thereon to the Board of Guardians of the said Union, in like manner as therein set forth with reference to the securities of other officers.
