THE Board of Trade have received through the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a copy of a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at Aleppo, stating that in consequence of the disappearance of plague from Mesopotamia the qua antine stations established in the neighbour-

hood have been withdrawn. The Consul adds that, notwithstanding the precautions taken, cholera is raging with great violence in Aleppo.

THE Board of Trade have received from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a Despatch from Her Majesty's Consul at San José, Costa Rica, reporting that by a Decree of the National Congress of Costa Rica, dated the 6th July last, the duties on tallow, cocoa and palm oil, tar, resin, and salts of soda and potash for soap making are reduced to one half of the duties charged by the present tariff.
