Venice, January 15.

E have Advice by a Veffel come from Narenta, That fo foon as the Proveditore General Cor-

noro had Landed his Troops, the Turks abandoned the firing Tower of Narin, but being purfued by a Party of Horfe, the greatest part of them were cut in pieces, and the reft made Slaves, together with their Commander : That some few days after the Venetians made themselves Masters of another strong Castle in that Neighbourhood; after which, being able to make no farther progress, by reason of the continual Rains, his Excellency retired to a Place called Macarfa, where he would expect better Weather to undertake some new Delign. The Letters from the Levant lay, That the Doge Morofini had fixed his Head Quarter at Napuli di Romania, and that he was making Preparations, in order to renew the Siege of Negrepont, fo foon as the Seafon was proper for it. We are expecting with fome impatience the fuccels of the Treaty that's going to be fet on foot with the Turkith Ambassadors at Vefendorf, not far from Vienna, at which the Secretary Capello will Allift on the part of this lifepublick. ปก the mean time the Preparations for the War are not neglected. Commillions are given out daily for new Levies of Soldiers; and the Senate are now about Choosing a General to Command their Land Forces in the place of the late Velt-Marshal Coningsmarke. They have Ordered 4000 Men to be fent from Dal matia to the Levant's and have refolved so make a Levy of 3000 Suiffers.

Madrid, Jan. 14. The Marquis de Refenac, Amballados of France, does

press this Court to declare their Refolation concerning the Neutrality he has proposed, that fo the King, his Master, may know what Measures to take : Tiponwhich no other Antwer has as yet beend given him, than, That his Catholick Majefty has already given Orders to the Governor of Flanders, and his other Dominions, how to behave themfelves in this Conjuncture; and that he will take fuch farther Refolutions as may be most for ... the benefit and fecurity of them. But, it's expected, that a more particular and Negative Answer will be given him in few days. The French have carried the Effects, that came home in the New Spain Fleet, to Marseilles and Toulon, for fear of the Dutch, if they had gone by the way of the Ocean. The Marquifs. de los Balbaces offers 500 thousand Pistols for the Principality d'Aftilliano inthe Kingdom of Naples, which is fallen to the King by the Death of the Prince of that Name.

Vienna, Jan. 16 The Count de Piccolomini has written hither, that the new Fortifications are finished at Belgrade, and that the Place is at prefent in a posture of Defence. Colonel Mackaire is gone with 3000 Huffars, and a Body of the Militia, to re-inforce the Blockade of Sigeth, the Garifon whereof is reduced to that extremity, that's not doubted, but they will in a fhort time be forced to Capitulate. It is confirmed, that the Garison' of Great Waradin has Mutinied against their Officers, and, that the Baron de Heusler, upon the News of it, was advanced nearer to the Place with the Troops under his Command, to endeavour to draw fome Advantage from the Diforder a they were in. The 14th Infant was appointed for the Audience of the Turkift Ambassadors, but, for Reasons that are not yet made publick, ?cis put off for fome days longer.
