SOUTH BRENT FAIRS.

IN pursuance of the above-mentioned Act, I, the Right Honourable Richard Assheton Cross, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, hereby notify as follows :

1. A representation has been duly made to me by Jno. Beer and George W. E. Rundle, Esqrs., as owners, that Fairs have been annually held on Wednesday in the last week of February, and on Wednesday in the last week of August, respectively in the parish of South Brent, in the Stouborough and Cobridge Petty Sessional Division of the county of Devon, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the days for holding the said Fairs should be altered, and that instead of being held as aforesaid, such Fairs should in future be held on Tuesday in the last week of February, and on Tuesday in the last week of August respectively in each year.

2. On the 7th day of March, 1876, I shall take the aforesaid representation into consideration, and all persons are to intimate, before that day, any objection they may desire to offer to the said proposed alteration in the times for the holding of the said Fairs.
