THE Civil Service Commissioners hereby give notice that the following Regulations have been approved by the Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury:—

REGULATIONS respecting Competitive Examinations, held under the Order in Council of 12th February, 1876, for Men Clerkships in the Lower Division of the Civil Service.

1. Competitive examinations of candidates for Clerkships in the Lower Division of the Civil Service will be held from time to time at such places as may be deemed expedient.

2. These examinations are open, with such exceptions and under such conditions as may be laid down, to all natural-born subjects of Her Majesty, being of the prescribed age, and of good health and character. The undermentioned exceptions and conditions are at present in force:

(i.) The following classes of persons are ineligible; viz.:

(a.) Persons actually serving in the Army and Navy.
