

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Llansilin, in the counties of Denbigh and Salop, and in the diocese of Saint Asaph, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarages, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of twenty pounds heretofore paid by us, the said Commissioners, or by our lessee to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Llansilin in respect of the said and other yearly tithe commutation rent-charges and hereditaments, to which substitution the Reverend Walter Jones, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges for and in respect of the period intervening between the seventh day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
