WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twentyninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Christ Church, Burntwood, in the county of Stafford, and in the diocese of Lichfield, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the Schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us, to have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in substitution for a portion amounting to one hundred and fifty pounds per aunum of the yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and sixty-two pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Christ Church, Burntwood, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, bearing date the seventeenth day of November, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and published in the London Gazette of the twentieth day of the same month and year, to which substitution the Reverend George Poole, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument : And provided, also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-six, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
