| HILL STREET. | Five Carriages. Commencing six feet from crossing in Hill Street, in centre of Union Street, and extending forty yards towards Hay's Mews. |
| QUEEN STREET, Edgware Road. | Four Carriages. In Queen Street, Edgware Road, commencing opposite the first lamp-post from the Edgware Road in Queen Street, and extending along the centre of the said street as far as necessary for four hackney carriages to stand (horses towards the West). |
| MANCHESTER STREET, Manchester Square. | Four Carriages. In Manchester Street, Manchester Square, commencing at the South-east corner of George-street and Manchester Street, and extending along the kerb on the East side of Manchester Street towards Manchester Square as far as necessary for four hackney carriages to stand (horses towards the North). |
| LINCOLN'S INN FIELDS ... | Two Carriages. At the North-east corner of the Enclosure of Lincoln's Inn Fields, next the railings. |
| LINCOLN'S INN FIELDS ... | Two Carriages. At the South-west corner of the Enclosure in Lincoln's Inn Fields, next the railings. |
| ROYAL PARADE, Blackheath. | Twenty-seven Carriages. Commencing at South corner of Royal Parade, Blackheath, and extending along North side of road, Tranquil Vale, Blackheath, sufficient to accommodate twenty-seven hackney carriages. |
| GREAT WESTERN ROAD, Kensington. | Fifteen Carriages. In the Great Western Road, Kensington, commencing at the corner of Holland Lane, and extending by the footway under the wall of Holland Park towards the Lodge at the East end thereof. |
| TAMWORTH ROAD ... | Six Carriages. Commencing at the East end of Tamworth Road, on the North side thereof, and extending by the footpath towards the New Waddon Road as far as necessary. |
| UPPER ADDISCOMBE ROAD, Croydon. | Four Carriages. Commencing opposite the corner of the field adjoining the "Railway Tavern" Public-house, along the footpath on the South side of Upper Addiscombe Road, Croydon, towards George Street. |
| CAMDEN ROAD ... | Ten Carriages. Commencing fifteen feet from the Camden Road, and extending along the centre of York Road a sufficient distance for ten hackney carriages; horses' heads towards Camden Road. |
