ORDER issued by Local Government Board: Altering Name of Union.

Cannock (Penkridge) Union.

To the Guardians of the Poor of the Penkridge Union, in the county of Stafford;

To the Churchwardens and Overseers of the Poor of the several Parishes and Places comprised in the said Union;

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 13 of "The Divided Parishes and Poor Law Amendment Act, 1876," it is enacted as follows:—

"The Local Government Board may, when they see fit, by their Order change the name of any Union, and direct how such change of name shall be published; no such change of name shall affect any rights or
