"obligations of, or securities given by or to "the said Union, or render defective any "legal proceedings instituted by or against "the said Union; and any legal proceedings "may be continued or commenced by or "against the said Union by their new name "which might have been continued or com-"menced by or against the Union by their "former name."

And whereas by an Order dated the 5th day of September, 1836, the Poor Law Commissioners declared that the several parishes and places specified in the margin thereof should be united for the administration of the laws for the relief of the poor under the name of the Penkridge Union; and it is expedient that the name of such Union should be changed as hereinafter mentioned:

Now therefore, We, the Local Government Board, in pursuance of the powers given by the Statutes in that behalf, hereby Order as follows.

ARTICLE I.—On and after the fourteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventyseven, the name of the said Union shall be changed to the Cannock Union, and the Guardians of the Poor thereof shall be termed "The Guardians of the Poor of the Cannock Union."

ARTICLE II. — All Orders, Rules, and Regulations heretofore issued by the Poor Law Commissioners, the Poor Law Board, or the Local Government Board, to the Guardians of the Poor of the Penkridge Union, which may be in force in the said Penkridge Union, and in the several parishes and places comprised therein, on the thirteenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven, shall be and continue to be in force in the said Cannock Union, and in the several parishes and places comprised therein, as though they had been addressed to such Union by the name of the Cannock Union.

ARTICLE III.—The Guardians of the Penkridge Union shall cause this Order to be published for two successive weeks within one month from the date hereof, in some newspaper circulating within the Union.
