EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875 (38 Vic., c. 17).

WHEREAS by Section 68 of the above-named
Act, it is provided as follows:—

“The Council of any Borough which is assessed
to the county rate of any county by the Justices
of such county, and the Commissioners of any Im-
provement District, may, by order of a Secretary of
State made upon the application of such Council
or Commissioners, and published in the London
Gazette, be declared to be a Local Authority for
the purposes of this Act, and thereupon shall
become a Local Authority accordingly for such
part of their borough or district as is not included
in any harbour, to the exclusion of the Justices in
Petty Sessions:”
