

**The Bankruptcy Act, 1869. 1**

In the London Bankruptcy Court.

In the Matter of Edmund Burnett, of 38, Richmond-gardens, Shepherd's Bush, in the county of Middlesex, a Bankrupt.

Before Mr. Registrar Hazlitt, sitting as Chief Judge.
