

benefice and of the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Sarum the patrons of the same to the intent that your Grace may if on full consideration and enquiry you shall be satisfied with the said scheme certify the same and such consents to Her Majesty in Council.

And whereas the scheme and consents referred to in the said representation are in the words and figures following, that is to say:—

"SCHEME.

"That the chapelries of Malborough and South Huish and the hamlet forming part of the parish of West Alvington which is delineated in the map hereto annexed and therein coloured pink and is bounded on the north partly by the parish of South Huish and partly by a road adjoining the same parish and leading into the turnpike-road from West Alvington to the village of Malborough on the south by the road leading from South Huish to Salcombe on the east by the said turnpike-road and on the west by the parish of South Huish be separated from the vicarage and mother church of West Alvington and be together constituted a separate parish for ecclesiastical purposes and a perpetual curacy and benefice by the name or style of the perpetual curacy of Malborough and South Huish of which the church within the said chapelry of Malborough shall be the parish church and the church of the said chapelry of South Huish shall be deemed a parochial chapel annexed thereto but the inhabitants of the said chapelry of Malborough shall not be entitled to any sittings or accommodation in the said church of South Huish nor shall the inhabitants of the said chapelry of South Huish be entitled to any sittings or accommodation in the church of Malborough.

"That the inhabitants of the said hamlet shall resort to the parish church of Malborough as their parish church and shall be provided with sittings therein and the incumbent of West Alvington shall be discharged from all cure of souls within the said hamlet and the said chapelries of Malborough and South Huish.

"That the proposed separate parish and benefice shall be subject to the same ecclesiastical jurisdiction as the said vicarage of West Alvington and the incumbent of such separate parish and benefice shall have exclusive cure of souls within the limits of the same.

"That there shall be assigned and attached to the said separate parish and benefice of Malborough and South Huish the whole of the vicarial rent-charges in lieu of tithes payable in respect of land within the said parishes of Malborough and South Huish and all the glebe lands within the same parishes respectively together with the house of residence belonging to the said vicarage in Malborough aforesaid and the appurtenances belonging thereto which house shall be the house of residence for the incumbent of the said separate parish and benefice.

"That the whole of the vicarial rent-charges in lieu of tithes payable in respect of lands in the respective parishes of West Alvington and South Milton (including those payable in respect of lands in the said hamlet) and all the glebe lands within the same parishes of West Alvington and South Milton shall continue to belong to the said vicarage of West Alvington as so separated as aforesaid.

"That baptisms churchings marriages and burials and all other ecclesiastical offices shall as heretofore be performed in the said mother church of West Alvington and in the church of each of the said chapelries and that the fees for all such offices performed within the limits of the said parishes of West Alvington and South Milton as so separated as aforesaid and all ecclesiastical dues offerings and other emoluments arising from or in respect of the same parishes as so separated and usually payable to the incumbent of a benefice shall belong to the incumbent of the vicarage of West Alvington as so separated and the fees for all such offices performed within the limits of the said hamlet and the said chapelries of Malborough and South Huish and all ecclesiastical dues offerings and other emoluments arising from or in respect of the said hamlet and each of the same chapelries and usually payable to the incumbent of a benefice (other than and except the vicarial rent-charges in lieu of tithes payable in respect of lands in the said hamlet which are to belong to the incumbent of West Alvington) shall belong to the incumbent of the said separate parish and benefice of Malborough and South Huish.

"That one moiety of the first fruits, tenths and other ecclesiastical dues and of the annual rent or sum of two pounds thirteen shillings and eight pence to the Custos and College of Vicars Choral of the Cathedral Church of Saint Peter in Exeter now payable by the incumbent of West Alvington with the chapelries of Malborough South Milton and South Huish annexed shall continue payable by the incumbent of West Alvington as separated from the said hamlet and the chapelries of Malborough and South Huish and the other moiety thereof respectively shall be payable by the incumbent of the said separate parish and benefice of Malborough and South Huish.

"That churchwardens for the said parish of West Alvington as separated from the said hamlet shall be chosen by the inhabitants of the same parish as so separated and churchwardens for the said chapelries respectively shall continue to be chosen for the same respectively in the same manner as they are now by law appointed except that the inhabitants of the said hamlet shall be entitled to vote in the election of churchwardens for the said parish of Malborough.

"That the inhabitants of the parish of West Alvington as separated from the said hamlet shall continue liable to the maintenance of the parish church of the same parish and the inhabitants of the said hamlet shall cease to be liable for the same and the inhabitants of the parish of Malborough and the said hamlet shall be liable for the maintenance of the parish church of Malborough but shall not be liable for the maintenance of the parish church of South Huish and the inhabitants of each of the said chapelries of South Milton and South Huish shall respectively continue liable to the maintenance of the church of their own chapelry and the inhabitants of the said chapelry of South Huish shall not be liable to the maintenance of the parish church of Malborough.

"That from and after the proposed separation shall take effect the patronage of the said vicarage of West Alvington as so separated as aforesaid shall remain vested in and be for ever exercised by the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of the Blessed Virgin Mary of Sarum (the patrons of the said vicarage of West Alvington with the said chapelries annexed) and their successors and the patronage of the said perpetual curacy of Malborough and South Huish shall be vested in the said Alfred Earle as Vicar of the said vicarage of West Alvington as so separated as aforesaid so
