**T**HE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1869, and of

every other power enabling them in this behalf do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the twenty-third day of November, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven.

2. The Orders described in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.

3. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the said Orders, or any of them, before the date when this revocation takes effect, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the said Orders, or any of them.
