

## The Bankruptcy Act, 1869.

In the County Court of Lancashire, holden at Liverpool. In the Matter of Edward Elam, late of 92, Phythian-street, but now of 100, Bold-street, Liverpool, in the county of Lancaster, Builder, a Bankrupt.
