

The Bankruptcy Act, 1869.

In the London Bankruptcy Court.

In the Matter of Henry John Beckett, of 16 and 17, Bread-street, in the city of London, Silk Merchant and Agent, a Bankrupt.

Before Mr. Registrar Spring-Rice, sitting as Chief Judge.
