**T**HE Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1869, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

The Order of Council of the seventh day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, defining part of the premises known as Brown's Wharf, situate at Blackwall, in the parish of Poplar, in the county of Middlesex, as a part of the Port of London and landing-place within and at which animals brought from a port or place in France may be landed for quarantine, shall be read and have effect as if the words not exceeding fourteen days in the paragraph numbered 1 were not therein inserted, and, notwithstanding anything in that Order, the provisions thereof, except as hereinbefore mentioned, shall continue and be in force until revoked.
