## HIGH COURT OF JUSTICE.—CHANCERY DIVISION.

The Court of Justice (Salaries and Funds) Act, 1869.

WHEREAS by an Order made under the above-mentioned Act, on the 17th day of December, 1873, it was determined that George Thomas Jenkins, who had then recently been appointed to the office of Principal or Chief Secretary to the Master of the Rolls, should hold such office on a salary of £600 per annum, subject to revision thereafter in the event of any change taking place in the nature of the duties, and without any claim to compensation if the result of such revision or of any steps which might be taken after the coming into operation of the Judicature Act, should lead
