Vienna, June 26.

THeir Imperial Majesties intend to take a Journey towards the end of the next Month to *Neubourg*, to assist at the Ceremonies of the Queen of *Spain's* Marriage, which will be performed on the part of His Catholick Majesty by the King of *Hungary*. From thence their Imperial Majesties will go to *Ausbourg*; and before They return, it's believed, the King of *Hungary* will be elected and crowned King of the *Romans*. We have an account by Letters of the 19th Instant from *Belgrade*, That Prince *Louis* of *Baden* had been to visit *Semandra*, (whence he had withdrawn the Garrison) and the other Posts on that side; and that seeing the Imperial Forces were not yet all come up, and that those with General *Hofkirken*, who were posted to guard the Passages of the River *Morava*, began to want Forage and Provisions, which they could not without great difficulty be supplied with, he had sent Orders to the said General to retire and joyn the other Forces that were encamped near the Palanque of *Hassan Bassa*, being resolved to expect the Turkish Army, which, as 'twas reported, was come to *Nissa*, under the Conduſt of the Grand Viſier, at the River *Jassau*. We have certain advice, That the march of the Muscovites has obliged the Cham of *Tartary*, who was advanced with very considerable Forces into *Moldavia*, in order to fall into *Transilvania*, to return home with precipitation, to defend his own Country. There are Letters which say, That the Moscovites with a Body of 100000 Men were entred into the Heart of the *Crimæ*, and with another Body of the like number had passed the *Nieper*; and that they design no less than to attack *Constantinople* this Summer by way of the *Black Sea*, or by Land, or both. To morrow goes an Express from the Turkish Envoys to the Port.

Ratisbonne, June 23. The Emperor has sent hither the Articles of Neutrality offered by the Swissers, and has desired to know what the Dyet thinks of this Treaty, and whether it be such as consists with the Honor and Interests of the Empire, to Accept of, and Ratify. And this being a matter of great Consequence, the Deputies have written to their Principals for particular Instructions about it. There happened a Fire at *Prague* on the 21st Instant, which burnt down the whole quarter of the Jews, with 700 other Houses. The Damage is reckoned at 2 Millions.

Hydelberg, June 25. The Elector of *Bavaria* is gone to *Munche*, with design to return in 5 or 6 days to his City, which is encamped on the *Necker*. We hear from *Crau*, That a Fire happened there the 23d Instant, which in 6 hours time destroyed two Thirds of the Town, with the great Magazines of Forage and Provisions which the French had laid up there for the use of their Armies, and the Spoil they had brought thither from *Spire*, *Wormes*, and other places, which they have ransacked in the Palatinate.

Francfort, July 5. The Imperial and Confederate Forces continue to pass the *Rhine*, and a few days will now discover their Design. The old Regiment of *Stavembe*, consisting of 2200 Men, passed yesterday by this place in its march towards *Coblentz* to joyn the Imperial Army. We receive just now advice, That the Bavarian Forces, which had their Head Quarters at *St. Leonard*, were marched to *Seelsoffen*, which is not far from *Fort Louis*.

Hambourg, July 1. The Differences about the Dutchy of *Sleswicke* are at last happily accommodated, the Treaty having been signed last night by the Plenipotentiaries of *Denmark* and *Holftein*, and by the Mediators: The Ratifications are to be exchanged within 15 days, and the Dutchy of *Sleswicke* with the full Sovereignty, &c. restored to the Duke of *Holftein* within 8 days after. The King of *Denmark* offers to assist the Empire with 6000 Foot and 2000 Horse, and the other Princes that were concerned in this Affair, will be likewise now at liberty to send all their Forces against *France*.

Cologne, July 2. We hear from *Coblentz*, That several Regiments, as well of the Imperial Forces as those of the Prince of the Empire, had passed the *Rhine* there to joyn the Imperial Army which was encamped at *Mayen* about 7 German Miles from *Coblentz*. The Elector of *Brandenburg* arrived on Saturday last at *Nuss*; his Forces march in two Bodies towards *Bonne*: General *Paſſi* passed yesterday through this place going to his Electoral Highness from the Duke of *Lorraine*. A French Party appeared this Morning very near this place, but presently retired again.

Cologne, July 8. The Duke of *Lorraine* seems to have his Eye upon *Mentz*, having ordered his Army to repass the *Moselle*, except a Body of Horse commanded by the great Master of the Teutonic Order, which is to have its Station between *Mont-Royal* and *Bonne*. The Troops of *Saxony* and *Hesse* will pass the *Rhine* below *Mentz*, as those of *Hanouer* have already done at *Coblentz*, to joyn the Imperial Army. The Confederate Forces that besieged *Keyserwaert*, are marching in 2 Bodies to besiege *Bonne*, a Camp being marked for them at *Lusdorf*, not far from that place; and General *Schultz* is ordered to attack the Fort over-against *Bonne*, on the other side of the *Rhine*. The Prince of *Commercy* has been with 1000 Imperial Horse under the Cannon of *Bonne*, but without meeting any French Parties. The French have quitted the City of *Trier*.

Brussels, July 8. The Prince of *Waldecke* arrived here privately on the 2d Instant, to confer with our Governor-General concerning the Operations of the Campaign, and parted again the same day, being saluted with a discharge of the Cannon round the Town. The Dutch Army under his Command lies encamped between *Peruys* and *Gembours*, and so soon as the Convoys they expect from *Maaſines* and *Maaſtricht* have joyned them, will decamp and march towards the *Sambre*, which, it's believed, they will pass between *Namur* and *Charleroy*, in order to enter into the French Territories. The Prince of *Vaudemont* and Count *Horne* continue encamped with the Troops under their Command at *Deynse*, where they have been reinforced.
