

**The Bankruptcy Act, 1869.****In the London Bankruptcy Court.**

**In the Matter of George Smith, of 38, Studley-road, Clapham, in the county of Surrey, a Bankrupt.**

James Thomas Snell, of 53, Cannon-street, in the city of London, Public Accountant, has been appointed Trustee of the property of the bankrupt.
