THE DAIRIES, COW-SHEDS, AND MILK-SHOPS AMENDMENT ORDER OF 1879.

A T the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 28th day of February, 1879.

By the Lords of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1878, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1. This Order may be cited as The Dairies, Cow-Sheds, and Milk-Shops Amendment Order of 1879.
- 2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the making thereof.
  - 3. This Order extends to Great Britain only.
- 4. A person who carries on the trade of cowkeeper or dairyman for the purpose only of making and selling butter or cheese or both, and who does not carry on the trade of purveyor of milk, shall not be deemed to be a person carrying on the trade of cowkeeper or dairyman within Article 5 of The Dairies, Cow Sheds, and Milk-Shops Order of 1879.
