(Increase of Capital.)
NOTICE is hereby given, that the Louth and Lincoln Railway Company (hereinafter called "the Company"), have under and in pursuance of "The Railway Companies (Powers) Act, 1864," and "The Railways (Powers and Construction) Acts, 1864, Amendment Act, 1870," applied to the Board of Trade for a Certificate for the following, or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—
