Francfort, July 21. The 16th Instant the Duke of Lor-Francfert, July 21. The 16th Instant the Duke of Lor-raine advanced with the Imperial Army within two German Miles of Menez, sending before 4000 Croats, who had posted themselves near the Town; the French Horsein Garison there fallied out upon them, but perceiving their number, presently retired again. Four or five of the imperialists were killed with Cannon Shot from the place. The 17th the Imperial Army approached nearer to Manz, and began to take their Posts about the Town.
