

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Preston Candover with Nutley, in the county of Southampton, and in the diocese of Winchester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of and in full substitution for the following yearly sums or stipends, amounting together to fifty-five pounds and ten shillings, heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, or by our lessees, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said vicarage of Preston Candover with Nutley, that is to say, (first) for the yearly sum or stipend of thirty-two pounds, so payable by us as aforesaid, under the authority of an instrument sealed by us on the seventh day of July, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy, and published in the London Gazette of the fifteenth day of the same month and year; (secondly), for the two yearly sums, stipends, or pensions of seven pounds and sixteen pounds ten shillings respectively, also heretofore payable by us, or by our lessees, to the Vicar of Preston Candover aforesaid, and to the Vicar or Curate of Nutley aforesaid, respectively, in respect of the said and other tithe commutation rent-charges and other hereditaments; to which substitutions the Reverend Sumner Wilson, the present Incumbent of the said vicarage of Preston Candover with Nutley, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-ninth day of September, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the rectory of Thrupton with the vicarage of Kingstone annexed, in the county of Hereford, and in the diocese of Hereford, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same annexed rectory and vicarage, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed, shall be, and be taken to be, in lieu of and in full substitution for the following annual sums or stipends, viz:— (first), the annual sum of seventeen pounds, heretofore payable by us, the said Commissioners, to the Incumbent for the time being of the said rectory of Thrupton with the vicarage of Kingstone annexed, under the authority of an Order of Her Majesty in Council, bearing date the seventeenth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and published in the London Gazette of the twentieth day of the same month and year; and (secondly), the yearly sum or stipend of one pound six shillings and eight pence, heretofore payable by us, or by our lessee, to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Kingstone, in respect of the said and other yearly tithe commutation rent-charges and other hereditaments; and (thirdly), the annual sum or stipend also heretofore payable by us, or by our lessee, to the Incumbent of the said vicarage of Kingstone, in respect of the same tithe rent-charges and other hereditaments, in lieu of eight bushels of wheat, to which substitution the Reverend Thomas Thistlethwaite Smith, the present Incumbent of the said rectory of Thrupton with the vicarage of Kingstone annexed, is consenting, and in token thereof has signed this instrument: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same annexed rectory and vicarage shall be
