fumigated as soon as possible after coming on board, and again before arriving at Quarantine Station and the harbour of New Orleans.

(l.) Baggage-rooms, water-closets, dirty linen, lockers, cabins, and berths, should be kept thoroughly clean and disinfected.

(m.) The quarters of the crew should be kept

clean and disinfected.

The Captain and Medical Officer should direct their especial attention to the general hygiene of the crew and passengers.

THE Board of Trade have received from the Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs a Despatch from Her Majesty's Minister at Athens reporting that by a Law of the 24th April last (o.s.), the Greek import duties which have hitherto been levied in old drachmas (= 8.5d.) will in future be 'levied in new drachmas or francs (= 9.6d.) Goods imported into Greece will therefore be subject to an increase of duty proportionate to the difference between the old and new drachma.
