

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby grant and convey to the Incumbent of the vicarage of Compton Abdale, in the county of Gloucester, and in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol and to his successors, Incumbents of the same vicarage, the two pieces or parcels of land and hereditaments, containing together two acres two roods and thirty-four perches, or thereabouts, together with the appurtenances thereto belonging, particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and now vested in us: To have and to hold the said two pieces or parcels of land and hereditaments, with the appurtenances thereunto belonging, to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same vicarage shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the rents, profits, and proceeds of the said pieces or parcels of land and hereditaments, for and in respect of the period intervening between the twenty-fifth day of March, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, in consideration of a benefaction, consisting of two hundred and ninety-five pounds sterling, which has been paid to us in favour of the benefice of Saint Paul, Penzance, in the county of Cornwall, and in the diocese of Truro, and in consideration also of a further benefaction, consisting of a piece or parcel of land which has been permanently secured to the same benefice, do hereby, in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, sections five and eleven, grant and appropriate out of our common fund to the said benefice of Saint Paul, Penzance, to meet the said benefactions, one capital sum of four hundred pounds sterling, to be applicable towards defraying the cost of providing a parsonage or

house of residence for the said benefice, according to plans and a specification approved or to be approved by us, such capital sum, or the balance thereof unapplied to such purpose, to remain in the meantime in our hands at interest after the rate of three pounds per centum per annum, and such interest to be paid to the Incumbent for the time being of the said benefice of Saint Paul, Penzance.

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant to the Incumbent for the time being of the vicarage of Saint Augustine the Less, in the city and county of the city of Bristol, and in the diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, one yearly sum or stipend of one hundred and twenty pounds, such yearly sum or stipend to be payable out of the common fund under our control, and to be calculated as from the first day of May, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty, and to be receivable in four equal portions, on the first day of February, the first day of May, the first day of August, and the first day of November in each and every year: Provided always, that the annual sum or stipend so granted by us to the Incumbent of the said vicarage shall be paid only upon the production to us, on or after each of the said lastly-mentioned days in each and every year of a certificate under the hand of the Bishop of the said diocese of Gloucester and Bristol, that an Assistant-Curate, duly licensed by such Bishop, has been employed within the parish of Saint Augustine the Less, Bristol aforesaid, during the quarter of the year then ended, and is in receipt of a salary after a rate of not less than one hundred and twenty pounds per annum: Provided also, that such yearly sum or stipend shall continue payable as aforesaid so long only as may to us appear to be expedient under the circumstances from time to time affecting the said parish and vicarage of Saint Augustine the Less, Bristol.
