The Tramways Act, 1870.

Barton, Eccles, Winton, and Monton Local Board.
Notice of Intended Lease of Tramways in pursuance of the Tramways Act, 1870.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Barton, Eccles, Winton, and Monton Local Board intend, subject to the approval of the Board of Trade, by an indenture to be made between the Local Board, of the one part, and William Turton, of Leeds, in the county of York, Merchant, and Daniel Busby, of Liverpool, in the county of Lancaster, Coach Proprietor, of the other part, to lease to the said William Turton and Daniel Busby, the sole and exclusive right of user by them, their executors, administrators, and allowed assigns of the tramways next hereinafter mentioned, in the district of the Local Board, namely (first), a tramway commencing in the Liverpool-

road, at Peel Green, in the township of Barton-upon-Irwell, passing along Liverpool-road, Church-street, Regent-street, and part of the Eccles New-road, and terminating in the Eccles New-road at the municipal boundary of the borough of Salford, by a junction there with a tramway authorized by the Salford Tramways and Improvement Act, 1875; (secondly), a tramway commencing by a junction with the tramway first above-mentioned, at a point in Church-street, in the township of Barton-upon-Irwell, opposite the north-easterly corner of the house No. 100, occupied by Samuel Fish, in that street, and terminating in Eccles Old road, at the municipal boundary of the borough of Salford, by a junction with a tramway authorized to be constructed by the Salford Tramways and Improvement Act, 1875, and certain other tramways, all being sidings or passing places
