Rome, Septemb. 17.

HE Cardinal Colonitz arrived here the 11 inftant, and the next day parted into the Conclave; whore there are now 48 Car-dinals. They proceed hitherto very flowly. dinals. They proceed hitherto very llowly. Upon a Scrutiny forme days ago there were found 32 Blanks. In the mean time the Creatures of the lare Pope continue to have the fitrongeft Party. An Express has been fint to the Duke de Chaulnes, who is coming hither as Amballador from France, to let him know, That before he is recei-ved here in that quality, he must renounce all Pretention to the Franchifes of his Quarter, and the King his Malter mult qui Avignon. Te Deum has been fung in the Con-clave for the Victory obtained against the Turks at the Ri-ver Marana.

Genous, Septemb. 17. The 15th inftant arrived in this Port 28 French Galleys, with the Cardinals of Furstemberg, Bouillon, and Bonzi, and the Duke de Chaulnes; who were

Boulion, and Bonzi, and the Dure ac Chauines; who were complimented on the part of this Senate: And the next morning they continued their Courfe toward Leghorne, from whence they intend to pails to Rome by Land. Warfaw, Sept. 10. The Letters from Lemberg, of the first inflant, give an account, That the Crown-General had refolved to attack Caminice, where, as he was in-formed by feveral Deferters, there were but 1500 Men in Garifon; That in order thereunto he had caufed feveral Ratteries to be raifed, and that his Men were advanced Cration: I har in order increanto ne nau cause leveral Batteries to be raifed, and that his Men were advanced within Mulquet-flot of the place. We hear nothing of the Tartars, fince the advice we had of the Cham's being come to Budriack; and that he affembled his Troops, which, as 'twas given out, he delign'd to find to the Alfi-france of the Turks. We are told from Moleow, that their Fourier constraints we ware constraints but their Ge Forces were gone into Winter-quarters, but that their Ge-neral, Kneas Galitzen, pretended he would go into the Field again in the Spring with a very numerous Army. Vienna, Septemb. 25. We have an account from Poland, That the Forces of that Crown did formally attack Caminice, and that they had the first night carried on their Trenches 400 Paces. There are no Letters from our Army commanded by Prince Louis of Baden fince those of the 4th instant ; which was then encampt at 34godina, near the Moraua.

Hydelberg, Septemb. 29. The principal Prifoners taken by the Huffars (who were commanded by Count Palfi) in the late Rencounter they had with the Garilon of Philipsburg, are Monfieur d'Erigal, fift Captain, and who did the Dury of Lieutenant-Colonel of the Regiment of Auvergne ; Monlieur de Four, Major of the place, & Capt. in the Regiment of Normandy ; Monfieur de Courfel, Capt. of Fusiliers ; Monsieur Vandel, Lieutenant of Fusiliers; Monfieur Gallier, Lieu-

tenant in the Regiment of Normandy; Monfieur Genefte, Lieutenant in the Regiment of Auvergne; and Monsieur Mincour, Corner of Dragoons. Yeiterday a Party of Huffars took again leveral Prisoners near the Gates of PLinpsburg, and bronght them to their Quarters at Smitzbeim. The French have this week burnt Netflade, and feveral other places in the Palatinare,

Francfirt Octob. 2. The Elector of Saxong continues to have his head Quarters of Benfheim, and the Elector of Bavaria at Handschuckeim, near Hydelberg. The Duke of Duras has, upon the news of the lois which the Garifon of Philipsburg fuftained in the late Action with the Hussars, sent thither a Reinforcement of 1000 men from Landaw. There is a Bridge laid over the Mein at Costheim. And they are repairing that at Mentz.

From the Camp before Bon, Octob. 4. Brandenburgers have fince the first inftant bar-The tered the place with 42 whole and half Cannon, and have made great Breaches in the Walls. At the Dutch and Murster Attack their Cannon play likewife without intermission. But the Imperialists have not yet finished their Batteries, On the fecond inftant three Defetters came our of the Town, and reported that the Garilon was reduced to 2500 fighting men. Last night we advanced within 12 Paces of the Counterfearp. This day we have Planted several Pieces of Cannon on a new Battery near the Counterfcarp. And it's believed that on the 6 or 7th inftant we shall give a general Asfault.

Cologne, Octob. 4. The Troops of Hanouer are arrived in this Neighborhood : They intend to pass the Rhine at Dufeldorp, and from thence to continue their March towards the Spanish Netherlands. We hear from the Camp before Bon, That their Cannon had made large Breaches and that they were preparing to ftorm the place.

Hague', Oftob. 7. The Earl of Pembroke, Ambaffador Extraordinary from His Majefty of Great Britain, had yesterday his Audience of Leave of the States-General, to which he was conducted with the ufual Solemnity. We hear from Flanders, That our Army was ensamped the 4th inftant at Chievres; And that the Marefchal d'Humieres was retired towards Tournay.

Bruffels, Octob. 5. The Mareschal d'Humieres upon advice that the Spanifli and Dutch Forces advanced towards him, decamped the firft instant from Lefines, and marched to Leuzes and
