Borough of Portsmouth.

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Council of the Borough of Portsmouth did, at a Meeting held at the Guildhall, on the 8th of February, 1881, make the following Bye-laws:—

WHEREAS by the virtue of "The Tramways Act, 1870," the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the Borough of Portsmouth, acting by the Town Council of the said borough; as a Municipal Corporation, are the Local Authority within the District of the said borough of Portsmouth; and—

Whereas subject to the provisions of the special Act, authorizing any tramway; and of "The Tramways Act, 1870," the Local Authority of any District in which any tramway is laid down, may

from time to time make regulations as to the following matters:—

The rate of speed to be observed in travelling upon the tramways.

The distances at which carriages using the tramway shall be allowed to follow one after the other.

The stopping of carriages using the tramways.  
The traffic on the road on which the tramway is laid.

And for better enforcing the observance of all or any of such regulations, it is by "The Tramways Act, 1870," enacted that it shall be lawful for such Local Authority to make Bye-laws for all or any of the aforesaid purposes, and from time to time to repeal or alter such Bye-laws; and make
