NOTICE TO MARINERS.

(No. 70.)—NORTH SEA.

(1.) *Flashing Light on Ameland Island.*

WITH reference to Notice to Mariners, No. 215 (2), of the 18th November, 1880, on the intended exhibition of a light from a lighthouse then in course of construction on the western sand hill of Ameland Island:—

The Netherlands Government has given further notice, that the light will probably be exhibited during the first half of May, 1881:—

The light will show every half-minute, three white flashes in quick succession followed by an eclipse (triple flashing half-minute); it will be elevated 187 feet above high water, and should be visible in clear weather from a distance of 20 miles.

Position, lat. 53° 27' 0" N., long. 5° 37' 35" E.

BALTIC—COAST OF PRUSSIA.

(2.) *Colberg Harbour Light—Alteration in Colour.*

The German Government has given notice, that on 1st June, 1881, the following alteration will be made in the colour of the harbour light exhibited on the extremity of the East Mole at Colberg (Colbergmünde), in order that it may be better distinguished from the lights of the neighbouring buildings:—

The light will be a fixed red light, instead of fixed white as at present.
