

way of extension, so that they shall include an additional portion of the said parish of Wednesbury and also a portion of the new parish of Pleck and Bescot in the county and diocese aforesaid.

"Now therefore with the consent of the Right Reverend William Dalrymple Bishop of the said diocese of Lichfield (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this scheme or representation) we the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners humbly represent recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of any Order of your Majesty in Council ratifying this scheme or representation the boundaries of the said new parish of Saint Paul, Wood Green, Wednesbury shall be altered by way of extension so that they shall include all that portion of the said parish of Wednesbury and also all that portion of the said new parish of Pleck and Bescot, which said portions are described in the schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto appended and are thereon coloured respectively blue and pink, and that from and after the day of the same date and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order, the said portions of the parish of Wednesbury, and of the new parish of Pleck and Bescot, so to be included as aforesaid shall become and be and form part of the said new parish of Saint Paul Wood Green, Wednesbury.

"And we further represent recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or of either of them or of any other Act of Parliament.

"The SCHEDULE to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

"The territory proposed to be annexed to the new parish of Saint Paul, Wood Green, Wednesbury in the county of Stafford and in the diocese of Lichfield, being :—

1. "All that contiguous portion of the parish of Wednesbury in the county and diocese aforesaid wherein the present incumbent of such parish now possesses the exclusive cure of souls which is bounded on part of the north and on the south-east by the new parish of Saint Paul Wood Green Wednesbury aforesaid and upon all other sides, that is to say upon the west and upon the remaining part of the north by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides such new parish from the parish of Wednesbury aforesaid at the point where Walsall-street is joined by Pritchard-street, and extending thence northward along the middle of the last-named street for a distance of five and a half chains or thereabouts to its junction with a street and footway connecting Pritchard-street aforesaid with Terrace-street and with Windmill-street and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of the said connecting street and footway for a distance of two chains or thereabouts to a boundary stone inscribed 'W. W. G. St. P. N. P., 1881, No. 1,' and placed at the south-eastern end of the wall forming the south-western boundary of the houses and premises situate on the south-western side of Terrace-street aforesaid and extending thence north-westward along the said wall for a distance of six and a half chains or thereabouts to its junction with the wall forming the north-western boundary of the house and premises called or known as No. 20 Terrace-street and extending thence north-eastward for a distance of about one chain along the

last-described wall to a boundary-stone inscribed 'W. W. G. St. P. N. P., 1881, No. 2,' and placed at the north-eastern end of the same wall and continuing thence still north-eastward and in a direct line across the present north-western end of Terrace-street aforesaid to a point at the south-western end of the footway which leads into Windmill-street aforesaid and continuing thence still north-eastward along the middle of the last-described footway for a distance of two chains or thereabouts to its junction with Windmill-street aforesaid and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the last-named street for a distance of four chains or thereabouts to its junction with Vicarage-road, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of the last-named road for a distance of eleven and a half chains or thereabouts to the boundary which divides the said new parish of Saint Paul Wood Green Wednesbury from the parish of Wednesbury as aforesaid.

"2. All that portion of the new parish of Pleck and Bescot in the said county of Stafford and in the diocese of Lichfield aforesaid, which is bounded on the south by the new parish of Saint Paul Wood Green Wednesbury aforesaid, or in other words by the old course of the River Tame, and on all other sides that is to say on the east, on the north and on the west by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the last-named new parish from the new parish of Pleck and Bescot aforesaid at the point where such boundary is crossed by the Bescot Branch of the London and North-Western Railway, and extending thence north-westward along the middle of the said branch line of railway for a distance of twenty-eight chains or thereabouts to its junction with the main line of the London and North-Western Railway aforesaid; and extending thence northward along the middle of the said main line of railway for a distance of six chains or thereabouts to the point where it crosses Wallows-lane, and extending thence first westward and then south-westward along the middle of the said lane for a distance of twenty chains or thereabouts to its junction near Bescot Hall with the high road leading from Walsall to Wednesbury and extending thence southward along the middle of the said high road for a distance of fourteen and a half chains or thereabouts to its junction with a certain private road belonging to the London and North-Western Railway Company and leading from the said high road to the line of the Grand Junction Railway and extending thence south-westward along the middle of the said private road for a distance of six chains or thereabouts to the middle of the level crossing over the line of the Grand Junction Railway aforesaid and extending thence eastward along the middle of the last-named line of railway for a distance of one and a half chains or thereabouts to the centre of the bridge which carries the high road leading from Walsall to Wednesbury as aforesaid over the said last-named line of railway and extending thence southward along the middle of the said high road for a distance of two and a quarter chains or thereabouts to the boundary at the bridge which carries the same high road over the River Tame, which boundary divides the said new parish of Pleck and Bescot from the new parish of Saint Paul, Wood Green, Wednesbury aforesaid."
