WE, the Ecclesiastical Commmissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the twenty-ninth and thirtieth years of Her Majesty, chapter one hundred and eleven, section five, do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, grant and convey to the Incumbent of the benefice of Saint Mary, Hook-with-Warsash, in the county of Southampton, and in the diocese of Winchester, and to his successors, Incumbents of the same benefice, all and singular the yearly tithe commutation rent-charges which are particularly described in the schedule hereunto annexed, and are now vested in us: To have and to hold the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges (subject as hereinafter mentioned) to the use of the said Incumbent and his successors for ever: Provided always, that the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges expressed to be hereby granted and conveyed, shall be and be taken to be in lieu of and in full substitution for the yearly sum or stipend of two hundred and ninety-five pounds heretofore payable by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, to the Incumbent, for the time being of the said vicarage, under the authority of an instrument sealed by us on the twenty-seventh day of June, in the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy-two, and published in the London Gazette on the fifth day of July, in the same year: And provided also, that the Incumbent for the time being of the same benefice shall be entitled to receive from us, or on our account, the net amount of the profits and proceeds of the said yearly tithe commutation rent-charges, for and in respect of the period intervening between the first day of October, in the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-one, and the date of the publication of these presents in the London Gazette.
