Vienna, Novemb. 10. The Letters from W. of the 27th past give an account- That atter the Sucrender of that Castle on the 19th Prince Loun of Baden decamped from thence, and having passed the Daniel at a place called Vedifian, marched towards Valachia, to ferrle the Winter-Quarters which that Country is required to furnish for the Imperial Froops. At the samemine General Piceolomini was erecting a Magazine at Precopia, and had font a Detachement under the Command of a Prince of Hulftein, to secure the Pass at Lescowa. The news they had of the Turks, was, That the Seraskier lay with the Remains of their Army at Sophia, but that the Troops were in to ill a condition, and under such a Discouragement, that the least notice of the Approach of the Imperialists would in all probability disperse them?

Francfort, Nov. 16. We hear from Suifferland, That the Protestane Cantons have unanimoully forbid their Subjects to engage themeselves in the French Service, upon pain of death. Of the Froops of Saxony 5 Regiments are to have their Winter-Quarters in the Bergstract, and the rest will return home.

Cologue Nov. 22. There are now 1500 Brandenburgers in Garilon here; and 25 Companies of Foogand Troops of Horse are quartered in the Lower Diocels, their head Quarter being have pur assigned into the place; and four Battalions more with two Regiments of Dracons, ane saily expected there, fo that the Burgers will be forced to lodge 20 d 30 Men in every house. Hamburg, Novemb. 15. Brussels, Novemb. 18. There has been Published since my lait, a Placact; by which, All Persons, of what Demy latt, a Placact; by which, All Persons, of what Degree or Quality soever, are forbid to bring, or easily to be brought into these Countreys, by Sea or Land, any Wines, Brandy, Vinegar, Oyl, Salt, Pruins, or any other Commodities of the Growth of France, or the Countreys at plat bring in or receive the same into their Houses, Celum's or Warehouses, shall, besides the Fersetture of the Goods, or the Importation thereof, pay 600 Guilders for every Piece of Wine, Vinegar, or Brandy, and every Tun lue of Salt and all other things of the Growth of France. One Third to be to the Informer, another Third to the Officer prosecuting the same, and the other to the King. My Wine-Merchants, Factors and Vintners, are, within eight Give projecusing the same, and the other to the King. All Wine-Merchants, Factors and Vintners, are, within eight days after Publication hereof, to declare in Writing, and upon Oath, to the Magistrates of the place where they rejide, what Wines, &c.c. they have at that time in their Possifien, or belonging to them (which they may sell, or otherwise dispose of) upon the Panalties above mentioned. After the Expiration of the said eight days, the Magistrates and other Officers shall Visit the Houses, Cellars and Warelandes, of the Island Merchanit, Factors and Finners, to see whether the Quantity and Quality of the Winner, &c. they sind there do agree with their said Declaration. The Winnes, &c. that shall be brought in or found, contrary to this Prohibision, shall over and above the sersaid Penalties be shaved and desired. All Persons that are affing in the bringing in a conceasing of Winns, &c. shall be winded, and Sasach shall be made, upon any Information, as well in Religious Hauses and Aboves, as others.
