Fur clothing covered with stuff, including fur caps, pays duty according to denomination, viz.: Articles of fur clothing for men, covered with cloth and other woollen stuffs, pay under point 3, and those for women under point 4; fur clothes covered with velvet, half velvet, and other silk or half silk tissues, pay duty under point 5 of this paragraph, with a reduction of 50 per cent. from the duty fixed under the last point.			
	Observation 2.—Caparisons, coverlets, curtains, blinds, and similar articles, hemmed and stitched, pay duty according to the principal material of which they are made.
