(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.)

AT the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 30th day of August, 1882.

By Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1878, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The Area described in the Schedule to this Order is hereby declared to be an Area infected with foot-and-mouth disease.

2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the first day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two.

An area comprising so much of the parishes or townships of Newton Solney, Bretby, and Wins-hill, in the county of Derby, as lies within the following boundaries, that is to say, from the Unicorn Inn Newton Solney up Newton-lane by Mr. Spooner's farm to the top, thence to the right
