(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.)

T the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 10th day of November, 1882.

By Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1878, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The following Area (namely),—the township of Marchington Woodlands, and so much of the townships of Marchington, and Draycott-in-the-Clay, and of the parishes of Abbots Bromley, and Uttoxeter, as are bounded by the main-road from Doveridge to Uttoxeter town, thence by the turnpike-road to Abbots Bromley village and that from there to Newborough, by the boundary of the township of Newborough from the last-mentioned turnpike-road to that from Yoxall to Sudbury, by this turnpike-road to the river Dove, and by the river Dove to the main-road aforesaid, all in the county of Stafford,—which was declared by Order of Council dated the second day of September, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, to be an Area infected with foot-and-mouth disease, is hereby declared to be free from foot-and-mouth disease, and that Area shall, as
