The time during which the killing, wounding, and taking of wild birds is prohibited, shall be varied in the liberty of Peterborough, in the county of Northampton, so as to be from the 15th day of March to the 31st day of August, in each year, both dates inclusive.

Now, therefore, I, the Right Honourable Sir William Vernon Harcourt, one of Her Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the said Act, and on such application as aforesaid, hereby order as follows :-

The time during which the killing, wounding, and taking of all wild birds is prohibited, shall be varied in the county of Essex, so as to be from the 15th day of March to the 1st day of August in each year.
