(FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE.)

AT the Council Chamber, Whitehall, the 6th day of January, 1883.

By Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council.

THE Lords and others of Her Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Act, 1878, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. The following Area (namely),—at Hadden-

ham, in the Liberty of the Isle of Ely, comprised within the following boundaries, that is to say, the Great Eastern Railway on the north, the Catchwater drain on the south and east, and the outward boundary Dyke of Henry John Porter's farm from the Great Eastern Railway to the Catchwater drain in line with the Two Pots Public-house on the west,—which was declared by Order of Council dated the twenty-eighth day of November, one thousand eight hundred and eighty-two, to be an Area infected with foot-and-mouth disease, is hereby declared to be free from foot-and-mouth disease, and that Area shall,
