Vienna, Jan. 6. E have an account, by Letters of the 9th past, from the Frontiers of Valachia, That, on the 7th, the Baron de Heusler began his march from Transilvania towards that Province, with the Regiments of Herbe ille and Magni; that the Baron de Parz was to follow three days after with his Regiment of Cuiraffiers, and that of Heufler; that a Battalion of Archinto was ordered to march at the same time from Cronstadt; and that these Forces were to joyn together, in order to put a strong Garison into Bagarest, a very large and well built City, the Residence of the Hospodar of Vala-chia, within 12 Miles of the Danibe; where there are to remain 7 Imperial Regiments during the Winter: The other Regiments, that have suffered more by the Fatigues of the last Campagne, will be quartered in fuch places as are the least exposed to the Incursions of the Tartars; and for their greater Security, General Heusler had ordered the Passages of the River Aluta, and some other Posts, to be sortified. The Baron de Parz is to remain with General Heuster at Bagarest, but his new Regiment of Dragoons, with five Troops of Biden, are to return to Transilvania, to joyn the five Regiments that are to continue at Cronslad. Prince Louis of Baden parted from hence the third instant for Ausbourg; and from thence will go to Bohemia to conclude the Marriage that's treating between him and the Eldelt Princess of Saxe-Lawembourg. The Imperial Court is expected back here towards the end of the next month.

Ausbourg, Jan. 6. All things are preparing here for the Coronation of the Empres, which will be performed the 16th of this month by the Abbot of Fulda, whose Privilege it is: And Opera's and Comedies are to entertain the Court three days The 18th is to be the Election of the King of the Romans, on which day all Foreign Ministers are (according to usual Custom,) to go out of the Town, lest they may be thought to influence the Ele-ctors in their Votes. The Capitulation, which the King of the Romans is to Swear to, is not yet finished, but is at present the Subject of their Conferences, which are thus managed; The Electors and the Plenipotentiaries of those that are absent fit at a Table by themselves; and at another Table, in the same Room sit their Privy Councillors, who debate, in their presence, the Matters they refer to them. The Lord Paget, Envoy Extraordinary from His Majesty of Great Britain, had this day a private Audience of the Emperor; and the Count of Coning see will part from hence in two or three days, in the same Quality, for England. The Duke of Holstein, who commands the Emperor's Forces in Bulgaria, makes daily Progreffes against the Turks, notwithitanding the tigor of the Season. The Im-

perialists have already raised 600000 Floring out of Valuchia, and proportionably from Servil, Bulgaria, and Albania. There are 7 Imperial Regiments quartered at Bagareft, the chief Residence of the and Albania. Prince of Valachia.

Hamburgh, Jan. 10. The last Letters from Berlin tell us, that on the 2d inftant an Envoy arrived there from the Elector of Mentz, as Chancellor of the Empire, to Notifie, to his Electoral Highness of Brandenburgh, that the 18th of this month is appointed for the Election of a King of the Romans, and to defire him to repair to Auchurg, to be prefent at the Electoral Dyet held there for that purpofe. The same Notification has been made to the Elector of Saxony. But they have both, as we are informed, excuted themselves from chinting in Person at that Solemnity. The Letters from Stockbolm, of the first instant, say, the new Levies, and other Preparations against the next Campagne, are continued there with extraordicary diligence.

Cologne, Jun. 13. The French Parties from Homburg, Sar Louis, Surbrug, and other Garifons on the Moselle, have this week burnt about 15 Villages in this Diocese, and in the Country of Juivers. The Deputies of the Chapter and City of Aix la Chapelle passed, two days ago, through this place on their Journey to Ausbring, with the Imperial Ornaments that are to be used at the Coronation of the Empres, and the King of the Romans, having with them a Convoy of 25 Brandenburgh Horse. The Deputies of this City are likewise on their way thither. They write from Basse, of the 5th instant, that a Gentle-woman had been seized at Berne, by whose means the French Ambaffador managed his Intrigues and private Correspondences, and that upon her Examination, the had discovered Matters of great Importance; there were found in her Lodging feveral great Sums of Money, and Letters written in Cypher

and under false Names.

Hague, Jan. 20. The Westerly Winds do still keep the Queen of Spain at Flushing, where her Majesty has been ashore at one of the Burghermasters Country-Houses to reiresh her self. The Earl of Portland arrived here on the 18th instant from England, and the next day received the Visits of all People of Quality here. Don Colomna, the Spanish Envoy, has declared, that he is impowered to act at the Conference that's going to be held here of the Ministers of the Allies, as Plenipotentiary for the Crown of Spain. The Count de Berka is coming hither in the same Quality from the Emperor. And, it's faid, toat the Court of Oxersterne, who is now here, is named to will at this Meeting on the part of the Crown of Suches.
