#### THE FAIRS ACT, 1873.

##### GRANTHAM FAIR.

WHEREAS a representation has been duly made to me, as Secretary of State for the Home Department, by the Mayor, Aldermen, and Burgesses of the borough of Grantham, as owners, that a Fair has been annually held within the town or borough of Grantham, on the Sunday of the Passion of Our Lord, in Lent, and on the three days then next following, and that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the said Fair should be held in each year on some days, namely, the first Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in April other than those on which such Fair is used to be held:

And whereas notice of the said representation, and of the time when I should take the same into consideration, has been duly given to the Justices acting in and for the borough of Grantham within which the Fair in question is held, and otherwise published in pursuance of "The Fairs Act, 1873:"

And whereas, on such representation and consideration, it appears to me that it would be for the convenience and advantage of the public that the time for the holding of the said Fair should be altered as proposed:

Now, therefore, I, as the Secretary of State for the Home Department, in exercise of the powers vested in me by "The Fairs Act, 1873," do hereby order that the days shall be altered for the holding of the Fair which has been annually held in the town or borough of Grantham, and that such Fair which has hitherto been held in the town or borough of Grantham on the Sunday of the Passion of Our Lord in Lent, and on the three days then next following in each year, shall in future be held instead on the first Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday in April in each year.

#### TENDERS FOR LOANS ON TREASURY BILLS.

1. THE Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Chief Cashier's Office at the Bank of England, on Monday, the 2nd proximo, at one o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Act 40 Vic., cap. 2, to the amount of £1,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of £1,000, £5,000, or £10,000. They will be dated the 6th day of July, 1883, and will be payable at

three or six months after date (at the option of the persons tendering), viz.:—on the 6th October or 6th January next, respectively.

3. The Tenders must specify the net amount per cent. which will be given for the amounts applied for; and the tenders of private individuals must be made through a London Banker.

4. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England.

5. The persons whose Tenders are accepted will be informed of the same on Tuesday, the 3rd proximo, and payment in full of the amounts of the accepted Tenders must be made to the Bank of England not later than three o'clock, on Friday, the 6th proximo.

6. The Lords Commissioners of Her Majesty's Treasury reserve the right of rejecting any Tenders.

ORDER of the Local Government Board under the District Auditors Act, 1879: Assignment of Districts and Duties (Supplemental):—

Northamptonshire Audit District.  
 Brackley, Kettering, Kingscliffe, Norman Cross,  
 and Weedon Highway Districts.

To William Floyd, District Auditor;—

To the Highway Board for each of the Highway Districts of Brackley, Kettering, Kingscliffe, Norman Cross, and Weedon;—

And to all others whom it may concern.

WHEREAS by Section 4 of "The District Auditors Act, 1879," it is enacted that the Local Government Board may from time to time assign to District Auditors their Duties, and the Districts in which such Auditors respectively are to act, and may from time to time change wholly or in part such Duties or Districts;

And whereas by an Order dated the 14th day of May, 1883, the Local Government Board certified the appointment of the said William Floyd as a District Auditor, and ordered and prescribed that the District in which he should act as Auditor, and which was thereby assigned to him, should, until the said Board should otherwise prescribe, comprise the area for the time being included in the several Unions named in the Schedule to that Order, and that such District should be termed "The Northamptonshire Audit District";

And whereas it is prescribed by Article 2 of the said Order that it shall be the duty of the said District Auditor to audit the Accounts of the Guardians and the Overseers specified in Nos. (1) and (2) of that Article, as well as the Accounts of the other Authorities (and of their Officers) referred to in Nos. (3) and (4) in the following terms:—

"(3.) The several other Authorities for the time being whose Accounts are or may be by law subject to be audited by a District Auditor, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being wholly situated within the said Audit District.

"(4.) Such of the said other Authorities whose accounts are or may be by law subject to be so audited, and whose Districts or the areas of whose jurisdiction are for the time being partly situated within the said Audit District, as We may by Order under Seal hereafter prescribe."
